PHILIPPIANS 1

⁴always in every prayer of mine for the steadfastness of you all, making request with joy,

²²But if I live in the flesh, ye are the fruit of my labour, yet what I shall choose I know not. ²¹For me to live is to do the will of Christ, and to die is my gain.

²³Now I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart and to be with Christ, which is far better.

²⁶That your rejoicing with me may be more abundant in Jesus Christ for my coming to you again.

²⁷Therefore let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ, that whether I come and see you or else be absent I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one Spirit with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel, ²⁸and in nothing terrified by your adversaries who reject the gospel, which bringeth on them destruction but [on] you who receive the gospel, salvation—and that of God.
