Assyria in the northeast and Egypt in the southwest were the opposite ends of the Fertile Crescent and were the dominant world powers of the day. Egypt was divided into three regions: the Delta (Egypt), the Nile Valley (Pathros), and Ethiopia in the south (Cush). Elam and Shinar are the southeastern tip of the Fertile Crescent.
